***HUDSON v. UNIVERSAL STUDIOS, INC***

***FINALLY...HUDSON'S ORAL ARGUMENT HAS BEEN SCHEDULED FOR MAY 4, 2007 AT 10:00A.M BEFORE THE SECOND CIRCUIT COURT OF APPEALS IN THE CEREMONIAL COURTROOM (9<sup>TH</sup> FLOOR), Daniel Patrick Moynihan United States Courthouse, 500 Pearl Street, Manhattan, New York City: DOCKET # 06-3337-cv; 04-CV-6997(GEL) SDNY;***

New York Playwright Gregory L. Hudson (who has been representing himself in court since 2003 and has fought Universal Pictures, Eddie Murphy and others all the way to the United States Supreme Court) over the copyrights for the hit movie *LIFE* is waiting to argue his \$75 million dollar copyright infringement and Breach of Implied-In-Fact contract (for his stage play drama *BRONX HOUSE*) before the 2<sup>nd</sup> Circuit Court of Appeals.

The defendants and their attorneys, Richard Dunnay (Lead Counsel) and Thomas Kjellberg (Co-counsel) are claiming "Res Judicata" (claim preclusion); in layman terms...they are claiming that Hudson's lawsuit was "previously adjudicated/heard" in the Eastern District Court of New York (EDNY) before District Judge Fredrick Block.

Hudson notified the Honorable Dennis Jacobs, Chief Judge for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Circuit Court of Appeals that "formal charges were being filed against Circuit Judges Richard C. Wesley and Peter W. Hall for Judicial Misconduct" when Hudson last appeared before the 2<sup>nd</sup> Cir. Hudson also requested that these two judges not preside over the March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2007 argument. Hudson has recently filed charges against District Judge Block, District Judge Lynch, Magistrate Judge Theodore H. Katz and former Chief Judge Michael Mukasey who recently retired from his \$165,000.00 a year salary to his new \$1.2 million salary with his former firm; who just so happened to have represented Universal. *Hudson also informed the Connecticut Bar Association, the University of Connecticut (where attorney Claudia Baio teaches/taught a law course and, the Hartford County Bar Association (where Mrs. Baio is currently "President Elect" of her "despicable misconduct" while she served as his attorney*
